
Physical Task Assessment October 18, 2015

- The physical task assessment is a task oriented examination utilized to measure your ability to perform functions that you will encounter as a police officer.
- The physical task assessment consists of the following four timed events:
 1. Police Pursuit
 2. Fire Rescue
 3. Rapid Aid Endurance Run
 4. Swim Test
- The cumulative time for the Police Pursuit, Fire Rescue, and Rapid Aid Endurance Run will be 120.0 seconds and below.
- The time for the swim test is 1 minute 45 seconds and below.
- **Candidates that fail to complete the Physical Task Assessment in accordance with the above listed times will not advance to the next step of the process.**



2. Fire / Rescue Event



Swim Test

- You will be required to swim 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ laps in a 25 meter pool, stop, tread water momentarily and then dive down and retrieve a weighted object and bring it to the side of the pool.
- You **MUST** complete this within 1 minute and 45 seconds.

TRPD Tattoo Policy:

- Tattoos or Similar Markings (All)
 - a. Definitions:
 - 1) Tattoo - the act or practice of marking the skin with designs, forms, figures, art, etc.
 - 2) Scarification - the act of intentional cutting of the skin for the purpose of creating a design, form, figure or art.
 - 3) Branding - the act of intentional burning of the skin for the purpose of creating a design, form, figure or art.
 - b. The following tattoos, scarifications and brands are prohibited:
 - 1) Any tattoo, scarification or brand located on the head, face or neck.
 - 2) Depictions of nudity or violence; sexually explicit or vulgar art, words, phrases or profane language; symbols likely to offend other members, employees, or members of the public, i.e., swastikas, pentagrams or similar symbols; initials, acronyms or numbers that represent criminal or historically oppressive organizations, i.e., AB, KKK, SS, MM, BGF, HA, 666, or any street gang names, numbers and/or symbols; or, any language or depiction that may impair or disrupt the operations of the Department, or is inconsistent with the mission of the Department..
 - c. Tattoos
 - All uniformed employees hired after December 30, 2012 shall not have any tattoos, brands, body piercings and other body art visible while a member is in uniform or other business attire.

Tattoos are not allowed on the head face or neck or on the hands up to the wrist. Any candidate having tattoos on the arms below the area covered by short sleeves would be required to wear long sleeves at all times while on duty.
